MAIN RING

NOVELTY SHOW JUMPING CLASSES – 10.00 a.m.

Classes 1-5 open to horses and ponies, riders any age. If sufficient entries classes will be split into separate pony and horse classes. Please state when entering if you are riding a horse or pony.

- 1. HORSE & GROOM – 1 HORSE/PONY + 1 RIDER + 1 GROOM (RUNNER!)**
The horse/pony and rider jump half the course then pass the whip to the groom who then jumps the rest of the course 'on foot'. One round against the clock, fastest time wins. 5 seconds added for a knockdown.
- 2. HORSE & HOUND – 1 HORSE/PONY + 1 RIDER + 1 DOG + 1 DOG HANDLER**
The horse/pony and rider jump half the course then the dog and handler jump the rest of the course. (Dogs must be kept on leads at all times) One round against the clock, the fastest time wins. 5 seconds added for a knockdown.
- 3. PAIRS – 2 HORSES/PONIES + 2 RIDERS**
The first horse/pony and rider jump the course, then pass the whip to the second horse/pony and rider who then jumps the course. One round, fastest time wins. 5 seconds added for a knockdown.
- 4. CHASE ME CHARLIE – 1 HORSE/PONY + 1 RIDER**
High jump competition where a vertical jump increases in height each round until there is a winner.
- 5. ACCUMULATOR – 1 HORSE/PONY + 1 RIDER**
The course must be jumped in number order with points gained for each fence jumped, e.g. No. 1 = 1 point, No 2. = 2 points etc. with a joker fence at the end where there will be two options, jump the higher fence and gain 20 bonus points, knock it down and lose 20 points! One round, highest score in fastest time wins.

Entries: Classes 1-3 £4 per class, Classes 4 & 5 £2.50 per class. Rosettes to 6th.

RING 3

*** ALL CLASSES IN THIS RING TO BE PAID FOR AT THE RING ***

HANDY PONY/HORSE – 10.30 a.m. to 12.30 p.m.

This ring will be open for 2 hours for Handy Pony, just pay at the ring then take your turn. The course will be against the clock, fastest time wins, time penalties will be added for non completion of an obstacle.

- 6. LEAD REIN – Rider 7 years and under.**
- 7. 12 YEARS AND UNDER – (Excluding Lead Rein)**
- 8. 13 YEARS AND OVER.**

NON HORSE EVENTS - For family, friends etc. 1 p.m. onwards.

- 9. WHEELBARROW RACE – Approx. 1 p.m. to 2 p.m.**
Complete the course in the fastest time to win. Will be split junior/senior if sufficient entries.
- 10. WELLY WANGING – Approx. 2 p.m. to 3 p.m.**
To be split junior/senior if sufficient entries. 2 throws per person.

24. DOG JUMPING
Over horse jumps. Will be split small/large breeds if sufficient entries. One round against the clock. Dogs must be kept on leads at all times. 5 seconds added for a knockdown.
25. DOG WITH THE WAGGIEST TAIL
26. BEST 6 LEGS
27. PRETTIEST BITCH
28. HANDSOME DOG
29. BEST VETERAN – 7 years and over.
30. YOUNG HANDLER – 10 years and under.
31. DOG JUDGE WOULD MOST LIKE TO TAKE HOME

Entries at the ring: Classes 24-31 £1 per class. Rosettes to 6th.

Entry money will not be refunded once the entry has been made.

Hats must be to the minimum standard, with a harness properly adjusted and fastened. Hats marked EN1384, PAS015; 1998, ASTM F1163, BSEN14572; 2005, or SE1 American Standard SNELL E2001, ASTM 95, SNZ3838; 1998. Skullcap hats must be worn with a silk.

Any complaint must be lodged at the Secretary's caravan with the payment of £5, which will be forfeited should the objection not be sustained.

The committee reserve the right to refuse an entry.

Any rider on leading rein must remain on it whilst on the show ground,
